SELF-ASSESSMENT TOOL FOR UNREGULATED PROVIDERS OF CHILD AND YOUTH CARE

Am I Required to Register with the College of Counselling Therapy of Alberta (CCTA)?

Child and youth care providers support the health and well-being of children and youth. Only providers who perform the scope of practice of a Child and Youth Care Counsellor (CYCC) and have acquired the competencies of a CYCC are required to be regulated by the CCTA. This tool is intended to help you self-assess as a child and youth care provider in Alberta if you must be regulated.

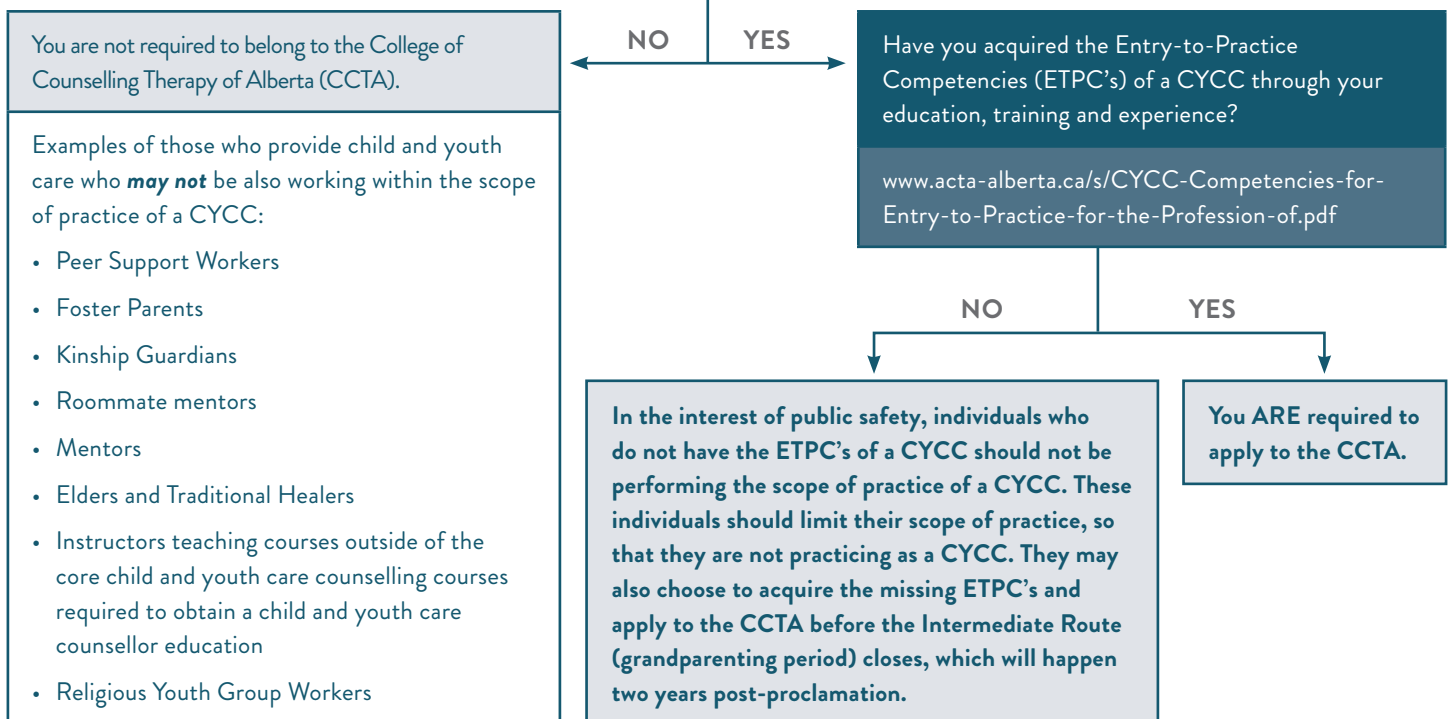

Are you working within the scope of practice of a CYCC?

Scope of practice of a CYCC:

In their practice, child and youth care counsellors do one or more of the following:

- (a) within a counselling relationship, assess, guide, support and treat children, youth and their families to enhance, maintain and promote health and wellness;
- (b) engage in education with respect to the practice of child and youth care counselling;
- (c) engage in research related to the practice of child and youth care counselling;
- (d) provide restricted activities authorized by the regulations.



Reminder: Providers who are not regulated by the CCTA cannot use the title Child & Youth Care Counsellor.
